***August is Child Support Enforcement Month***

**Batavia, Ohio.** The Board of Clermont County Commissioners is proclaiming August as *Child Support Enforcement Month*, to increase awareness about the importance of making timely child support payments. The program awareness theme for the August campaign is *Child Support Makes Dreams a Possibility*.



As part of the campaign, The Clermont County Department of Job and Family Services' Child Support Enforcement division is once again working with the Clermont County Sheriff's Office, Juvenile Court, Domestic Relations Court, Common Pleas Court, and the Prosecutor's Office to apprehend 397 parents who are behind in making over \$5.9 million in support payments to 511 children. This is the seventh annual *Most Wanted Roundup* in the county. Last August, Sheriff's Deputies resolved 149 warrants which resulted in child support collections of \$93,539 by the end of 2007.

Throughout the month of August, pictures of those who owe the most in child support payments will be featured in local newspapers, on Time Warner cable television access channels in the county, and will be available on the Web site [www.ClermontSupportsKids.org](http://www.ClermontSupportsKids.org).
